APPLICATION FORM

SFA Chapter 89, his family and friends have established an Annual Scholarship Fund for seniors from Los Molinos High School in Los Molinos California to HONOR the Memory of Allen C. Johnson, United States Army Special Forces. Allen’s Biography can be found at the web site at sfachapter89.com. APPLICATION CRITERIA: Annual scholarships will be granted to graduating High School seniors each year. Each applicant must:

- Be a United States Citizen
- Plan to attend and be accepted by a regionally accredited college, university, or Vocational School.
- Have maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average without receiving a failing grade in a given subject.

AWARDS: A scholarship in the amount of \$300.00 will be awarded each year to a graduating Los Molinos Senior. To receive a scholarship award, the recipient must provide documentation of full time enrollment in Los Molinos High School.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- Applications must be received by July 25th of every school year. Applications received after July 15th will be disqualified. Completed application forms must be returned to: Mrs. Chastity Eaton, 15 Cabernet Court Apt. 1D, Red Bluff, CA 96080. Telephone: (530) 528-0765.
- Applications will be judged by a committee appointed by SFA Chapter 89. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final. The student is responsible for the timely submission of the application forms and documentations.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS: The applicant **must** send in the following with this application form:

- Certification of acceptance and enrollment in the Junior College, College, University, or Vocational School the applicant plans to attend.
- Official copies of transcripts and cumulative grades from Los Molinos High School, copies of SAT and/or ACT test scores.
- Two letters of recommendation: one from a member of the community and one from an academic source (teacher, advisor or pastor).
- A statement of financial need (all financial information is confidential)
- A wallet size picture of applicant for possible publication in our SFA Newsletter and National Quarterly.
